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2007 **POUILLY FUMÉ** Domaine Hervé Séguin  
France, Loire £24.50  
Clean as a whistle - this classic Sauvignon has zingy and intense fruit underpinned by cool, refreshing minerality.

2006 **SAINT VÉРАН** En Crèches Domaine Daniel Barraud  
France, Burgundy £25.00  
This delicious White Burgundy has a lovely weight to it, yet remains elegantly aromatic with citrus fruits and a touch of minerality.

2006 **CHABLIS** Domaine Chantemerle, Adhemar Boudin  
France, Burgundy £26.00  
Monsieur Boudin's usual style, fresh and smooth, a succulence and weight to the fruit combine beautifully with the pebbly minerality - clean, long and vibrant.

2006 **CHASSAGNE MONTRACHET** Domaine Fernand & Laurent Pillot  
France, Burgundy £47.50  
With a broad rich flavour of grilled nuts, the style is fat and round, with juicy, ripe fruit - yet bright and mineral through the finish.

## Red Wines

2007 **TEMPRANILLO** Las Corazas Glass 175ml Bottle  
Spain, Castilla y Leon £3.75 £11.50  
Soft ripe fruit with a hint of vanillin oak make this Spanish red eminently quaffable...

2007 **MAS DE LA TOUR** Merlot Domaine Bonfils  
France, Languedoc £12.50  
Crisp and fresh style of Merlot with soft ripe fruits. Light, easy and perfectly made.

2007 **PEDRO DEL CASTILLO** Malbec Bodega y Cavas de Weinert  
Argentina £4.50 £13.50  
Brilliant value Malbec from Argentina's best and oldest family winery. Fruity and juicy with notes of deep dark fruits and a velvety texture.

2007 **BAROSSA 'CHOOK' RED** Australian Terroirs  
Australia, Barossa £14.50  
This Shiraz based blend is moderately full bodied and deeply spicy - yet remains easily drinkable. Biodynamically made to bring out the best of nature.

2006 **LEA AND SANDEMAN** Bordeaux  
France, Bordeaux £6.00 £16.50  
Classic modern Claret selected by our wine merchant- so good they put their name on it. Packed with glossy, silky fruit and just the right amount of traditional structure too.

2007 **CÔTES DU RHÔNE** La Dame Rousse Domaine de la Mordorée  
France, Rhône £6.00 £17.50  
Bright and juicy with fabulously crunchy, yet ripe Grenache fruit, soft tannins and warm spice. Quite delicious.

2007 **ASSISI Rosso Sportoletti**  
Italy, Umbria £18.50  
This blend of Sangiovese and Merlot is wonderfully expressive. It is beautifully aromatic, with masses of soft fruit and sweet oak tannins.

2005 **REY DON GARCIA RIOJA** Crianza Bodegas Ruconia  
Spain, Rioja £19.00  
Modern in its execution, yet with traditional values, this is a fruit led Rioja with crisp flavours and soft hints of oak giving a lovely creamy texture.

2006 **BOURGOGNE ROUGE** Pinot Noir Domaine Joël Rémy  
France, Burgundy £21.00  
Beautifully made fresh, crisp Pinot from the northern Côte de Beaune, as easy drinking as many New World Pinots but with a finer and drier texture.

2006 **TWINS SHIRAZ** Maverick  
Australia, Barossa £22.50  
Burley Shiraz from Barossa - but no brute. This is spicy and silky with a lovely weighty texture - immensely attractive and drinkable

2006 **CHIANTI CLASSICO** Poggerino  
Italy, Tuscany £25.50  
This is a brilliantly bright and juicy Chianti with glossy black fruit and a lick of acidity - so far removed from the dry and peppery styles of old.

2006 **PIKE & JOYCE** Pinot Noir Lenswood  
Australia, Lenswood £27.00  
Soft and supple but by no means 'Jammy' this is delicious and fresh with delicate red fruits - hard to stop yourself as this is such easy drinking.

2005 **CHÂTEAU PERRON** Lalande de Pomerol  
France, Bordeaux £28.50  
Round and mouth filling, succulent and long, this is delicious drinking - from Bordeaux's right bank - a modern classic.

2003 **CHÂTEAU LES ORMES DE PEZ** Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel St Estèphe  
France, Bordeaux £48.00  
Deep violet colour, velvety tannins, dark cherry fruit with nice freshness and acidity. Very long with great purity

2005 **GEVREY CHAMBERTIN** Domaine Thierry Mortet  
France, Burgundy £50.00  
This is an excellent round and fat example of what makes Burgundy the model for Pinot Noir - very precise and complex with black juicy fruitiness.

## Sparkling Wine

**PROSECCO FRIZZANTE** (Spago) Brut Il Follo Glass 175ml Bottle  
Italy, Veneto £6.00 £15.00  
This delicately sparkling Prosecco is soft and yet crisply refreshing - a very easy-drinking alternative to Champagne.

France, Limoux £20.00  
Amazing value French bubbles in the Brut Champagne style - but full of the sunshine and warmth from the hills around Limoux in the South-West.
